Article XI - ELECTION PROCEDURES

Section 11.05 Counting the Ballots (Const. Art. VIII, Sec. 10)

E. The tallying of the votes shall be open to observation by Tribal members, but they must remain quiet and in no way interfere with the orderly tallying of the ballots. If order cannot be kept, the Inspector shall halt the tallying until such time as order has been restored. Clerk #1 and Clerk #2 will tally the votes on separate Election Tally Sheet Form J-1

F. The candidates receiving the highest number of votes for the available positions shall be declared the winners for those positions. The Election Board shall certify all election results within three (3) days of the date of the election. The Tribal Council shall confirm the election results within three (3) days after the Election Board certifies the election results. (Const Art VIII Sec 12)

G. At the end of the tally, the Election Board shall determine the total votes cast for each candidate. The Preliminary Tally Results shall be written down on the Certified Election Results Form G-1, contained in Appendix I of this Ordinance. Each member of the Election Board shall sign the Certificate of Election Results. The Election Board shall post the Preliminary Tally Results at the polling place.

H. The Final Vote Results will occur one (1) week after Election Day to include those eligible Absentee Ballots arriving after Election Day. The tallying of the votes shall be open to observation by Tribal members, but they must remain quiet and in no way interfere with the orderly tallying of the ballots. The Election Board will post a Notice to the community to invite them to the Final Vote Results. The Final Vote Results shall be posted at the polling place.
